Sparkling Wines:

- Segura Viudas**, “Brut Reserve” Cava, Penedes, Spain, NV - **\$8 gl. / \$30 btl.**
-Dry, crisp, effervescent, and delicious. One of the best deals on our list.
- Agricola **Mionetto**, **Prosecco** Brut, Treviso, Veneto, Italy, NV - **\$10/split**
-A single serving is perfect for individual victories and group celebrations alike.
- Domaine Chandon**, Sparkling Brut, Sonoma & Napa Counties, CA, NV - **\$40 btl.**
-The domestic arm of famed Champagne house Moët & Chandon. Great bang for buck.
- Champagne **Taittinger**, “La Française” Brut, Reims, Champagne, FR, NV – **\$65 btl.**
-A relative bargain for Champagne, Taittinger always over-delivers with this entry level.
- Veuve Clicquot**, “Yellow Label” Brut Champagne, Reims, Champagne, FR, NV - **\$85 btl.**
-A classic, Pinot Noir-driven Champagne. One of Champagne’s most famous houses.
- Champagne **Dom Perignon**, Brut Champagne, Epernay, Champagne, FR, 2006 - **\$200 btl.**
-True Luxury. The world’s most famous & sought-after Champagne brand for a reason.

White Wines:

Sauvignon Blanc:

- Crossings** Wines, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand, '16 - **\$9 gls. / \$30 btl.**
-Pink Grapefruit, tart mango, & subtle grassy notes make this wine a crowd pleaser.
- Matanzas Creek** Winery, Sauvignon Blanc, Sonoma County, CA, '15 - **\$35 btl.**
-Exotic tropical fruit notes of gooseberry & passion fruit have made this estate famous.
- Domaine Gerard **Fiou, Sancerre** Blanc, Saint-Satur, Loire Valley, FR, '15 - **\$45 btl.**
-Dry, precise, and mineral, many believe Sancerre to be Sauv Blanc’s truest home.

Chardonnay:

- Maison **Laurent Miquel**, Chardonnay, Languedoc, FR, '15 - **\$8 gls. / \$30 btl.**
-An un-oaked value gem from the South of France brought to us by a local importer.
- Cambria** Winery, “Benchbreak” Chardonnay, Santa Maria Valley, CA, '14 - **\$10 gl. / \$35 btl.**
-Big green apple & ripe pineapple tones are supported by a kiss of French oak.
- Trefethen** Family Vineyards, Chardonnay, Napa Valley, CA, '15 - **\$40 btl.**
-A very nicely balanced example of Napa Chardonnay, not too fruity, not too oaky.
- Domaine Moreau-Naudet, **Chablis** AOC, Chablis, Burgundy, FR, '14 - **\$45 btl.**
-Un-oaked & mineral Chardonnay for the purists. Organically & Biodynamically produced.
- Ramey** Wine Cellars, Chardonnay, Russian River Valley, CA, '13 - **\$70 btl.**

-Rich, fuller bodied, and bold, this producer is at the top of the CA Chardonnay game.

Pinot Grigio & Pinot Gris:

-Agricola **Barone Fini**, Pinot Grigio, Valdadige, Friuli, Italy, '15 - **\$8 gls. / \$30 btl.**

-Crisp, fresh, and drinkable, this is everything people want their Pinot Grigio to be.

-**Sokol Blosser** Winery, Pinot Gris, Dundee Hills, Willamette Valley, OR, '15 - **\$35 btl.**

-Plenty of stone fruit, and a mineral twist on the finish make this a fun PG alternative.

Riesling:

-Weingut S.A. **Prüm**, "Essence" Riesling, Mosel, Germany, '15 - **\$9 gls. / \$30 btl.**

-A true semi-sweet style, but with enough acidity that it never comes across as cloying.

-Maison **Trimach**, "Reserve" Riesling, Ribeauville, Alsace, France, '14 - **\$40 btl.**

-Dry Riesling comes as a surprise for some, and a delight to others. Bone dry & crisp.

Other Interesting Whites & Rosé:

-Maison Laurent Miquel, **Rosé** of Cinsault & Syrah, Languedoc, FR, '16 - **\$8 gls. / \$30 btl.**

-A dry Rosé from the South of France. Think sunshine, watermelon, and strawberry.

-Bodegas Pazo Castrello, **Albariño**, Rias Baixas, Galicia, Spain, '14 - **\$30 btl.**

-A perfect pair with seafood, this crisp, dry, and fruity white if made on Spain's Coast.

-Bodega Colomé, "Estate" **Torrontes**, Salta, Argentina, '15 - **\$30 btl.**

-Wildly floral and exotic, this wine deserves a try if you've never had one before.

-Caposaldo Wines, **Moscato Frizzante**, Provincia di Pavia, Lombardy, Italy, '15 - **\$30 btl.**

-A semi-sweet and lightly spritz-y Moscato for after dinner or in a glass all by itself.

Red Wines:

Pinot Noir:

-**Moulin de Gassac**, Pinot Noir, VDP d'Herault, Languedoc, FR, '15 - **\$9 gls. / \$30 btl.**

-Dry and balanced, this French Pinot shows flashes of Burgundy for half the money.

-**Canon XIII** Wines, Pinot Noir, Santa Lucia Highlands, Monterey, CA, '14 - **\$12 gls. / \$40 btl.**

-A new winery producing a lush, and fruit-forward style of California Pinot Noir.

-**Soter** Vineyards, "North Valley" Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, OR, '14 - **\$45 btl.**

-A pioneer in Willamette Valley Pinot, Soter crafts wines of precision and balance.

-**En Route** Winery, "Les Pommiers" Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley, CA, '14 - **\$65 btl.**

-From the Pinot Noir production arm of famed California winery, Far Niente.

Cabernet Sauvignon:

-**Josh Cellars**, “Craftsman” Cabernet Sauvignon, North Coast, CA, '14 - **\$9 gls. / \$30 btl.**
-A blend of Sonoma & Napa fruit, this value drinks well beyond its price point.

-Wines of **Substance**, “CS” Cabernet Sauvignon, Columbia Valley, WA, '14 - **\$12 gls./\$40 btl.**
-91pts from Robert Parker’s Wine Advocate, a great example of Washington Cab.

-**Sean Minor Winery**, “Napa” Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, CA, '14 – **\$45 btl.**
-A relatively new upstart winery, producing wine that over-delivers for the dollar.

-**Jordan Winery**, Cabernet Sauvignon, Alexander Valley, Sonoma, CA, '12 - **\$85 btl.**
-The Jordan name has been synonymous with quality for almost 40 years.

-**Caymus Vineyards**, Cabernet Sauvignon, Oakville, Napa Valley, CA, '14 - **\$115 btl.**
-There may be no more famous name in Napa Cabernet than Caymus.

Merlot & Merlot Blends:

-Château de la Ligne, **Bordeaux** Superieur, Lignan, Bordeaux, FR, '12 - **\$35 btl.**
-A Merlot driven Bordeaux blend, with a little Cab Sauv & Cab Franc.

-**Freemark Abbey Winery**, Merlot, Rutherford, Napa Valley, CA, '13 - **\$55 btl.**
-A Napa Valley stalwart producer, who’s been making world class Merlot for decades.

Malbec:

-Bodega **Trivento**, “Reserve” Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina, '15 - **\$8 gls. / \$30 btl.**
-Reserve tier Malbec at this price point rarely happens. Long, dry, & robust.

-Bodega **Colomé**, “Autentico” Malbec, Calchaqui Valley, Salta, Argentina, '15 - **\$40 btl.**
-This un-oaked expression of Malbec is different and charmingly addictive.

Zinfandel:

-**Edmeades Winery & Vineyards**, Zinfandel, Mendocino County, CA, '13 - **\$10 gls. / \$35 btl.**
-A true classic Zinfandel with ripe cherry, spice box, and pepper notes.

-**Ridge Vineyards**, “Lytton Springs” Zinfandel, Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma, CA, '14 - **\$70 btl.**
-One of the most sought after and collected Zinfandel blends year in & year out.

Interest Domestic Reds:

-Michael David Winery, “**Petite Petit**” Red Blend, Lodi, California, '14 - **\$35 btl.**
-A famous and sought after blend of Petite Sirah and Petit Verdot. Big, bold, & dense.

-**Pendulum Winery**, Proprietary Red Blend, Columbia Valley, Washington, '13 - **\$35 btl.**
-A blend of Merlot, Cab Sauv, Syrah, and Malbec. Everything Washington does right!

Syrah, Shiraz, and Grenache:

-P. Lehman Wines, “**Clancy’s**” Shiraz Blend, Barossa Valley, Australia, '15 - **\$9 gls./\$30 btl.**
-Shiraz, with a little Cabernet Sauvignon & Cabernet Franc, from an Australian icon

-Domaine Galévan, **Côtes du Rhône**, Rhône Valley, FR, '14 – **\$10 gls. / \$35 btl.**
-*Organically made, and locally imported Grenache-based Cotes du Rhone*

-**Tenet** Wines, “Le Fervent” Costieres de Nimes, Rhône Valley, FR, '13 - **\$35 btl.**
-*A blend of mostly Syrah, with a little Grenache & Viognier, from Southern Rhône*
-**Copain** Winery, “Tous Ensemble” Syrah, Mendocino County, California, '15 - **\$50 btl.**
-*A dry, peppery 100% Syrah from one of California's top up-and-coming producers*

Italian Wines:

-Tenuta di Arceno, “Riserva” **Chianti Classico**, Siena, Tuscany, Italy, '12 - **\$40 btl.**
-Bold, dry, and rustic, this top-tier Riserva Chianti deserves to be savored with food

-Agricola Brandini, **Babera d'Alba** Superiore DOCG, Alba, Piedmont, Italy, '13 - **\$45 btl.**
-This soft silky and fruit-forward Barbera will charm with its drinkability.

-Agricola Arcanum, “il Fauno” **Rosso Toscana**, San Gusmé, Tuscany, Italy, '12 - **\$50 btl.**
-A true “Super Tuscan” style blend of Italian-grown Cab Sauv, Cab Franc, and Merlot.

-Agricola Prunotto, **Barbaresco** DOCG, Barbaresco, Treiso, Piedmont, Italy, '12 - **\$75 btl.**
-For the serious Italian enthusiast, this wine's racy acid and silky tannin will impress.

Spanish Wines:

-Familia Torres, “Altos Ibericos” **Rioja Crianza**, La Rioja, Spain, '14 - **\$10 gls. / \$35 btl.**
-*100% Tempranillo from one of Spain's most famous family run wineries.*

-Alfredo Arribas - Portal del Priorat, “Luno” **Montsant**, Tarragona, Spain, '13 - **\$35 btl.**
-*A blend of Grenache, Syrah, Cab, and old-vine Carignan, this wine over-delivers.*
